Dear Mrs. Holloway,

This is in answer to your enquiry concerning the parents of Nicholas DeVore, who was living in Mason County, Kentucky in 1797. Four of his children were married in Mason County: 1. Nicholas DeVore, Jr., born ca. 1776; married Polly Hall, daughter of Edward Hall, Jan. 18, 1779. 2. Abner DeVore, born ca. 1782; married Nancy Hamrick, Jan. 19, 1805. 3. Benjamin DeVore, born ca. 1784; married Nancy Fitzgerald, Nov. 16, 1805. 4. Sally DeVore, born ca. 1790; married James Stansberry, Dec. 14, 1809. We are glad to have this information to add to our files on Kentucky families.

There are no entries at all in our card catalog under DeVore and the few Fitzgerald entries yielded no clue. We have no family file on the DeVore family either. I checked E. G. Swem's Virginia Historical Index and found an entry only for a James DeVore listed. If The Filson Club has material on this family, it is buried inside volumes on other families.

The Kentucky Historical Society in Frankfort, Kentucky has a much larger genealogical collection than we and you might find it profitable to send a letter to them asking about the DeVore family. Until 1792 Kentucky was a part of Virginia, and there might be a possibility of locating facts at the Virginia State Library in Richmond or at the Virginia Historical Society, also in Richmond.

I wish I could report more encouragingly to you concerning these forebears of yours, but, alas, we seem to have virtually nothing easily accessible concerning them.

I am returning the letters you sent with your letter and thank you for the opportunity of seeing them.

Dear Sir or Madam:

I had the opportunity to do some research in your library last year, and noticed you had folders set up on various Kentucky families. I am enclosing some material for these files on the Devore and Martin families.

The Devore material includes family group sheets on Samuel Devore b. c1751 plus five more generations down to the present. My Devore line was in SW Pennsylvania, then Kentucky in the early 1800's, and moved on to Illinois. It is likely Samuel was the son of James Devore whose will was proved in Yohogania Co., VA in 1779 (now Washington Co., PA). Enclosed are copies of his will and Samuel's from Fayette Co., KY. Other researchers believe James may be the son of Hendrick Devoor whose will was proved in Hunterdon, N.J. in 1766; wife - Catherine. Hendrick may have been the son of Daniel Devoor b. c1660 with will proved at Hunterdon. N.J. 1724.

Enclosed is a family group sheet on James Martin b. c1770 whose son Pleasant married into the above Devore family. I have found very little material on James. Perhaps others can help. He evidently spent some time in Kentucky as his older children and young wife are shown as born in that state.

If you are aware of other material which would help me in researching the above families, I would appreciate a copy of it. I will be glad to pay for copies.

As Mr. Bentley has a crowded work schedule, just at this time, he has requested me to answer your recent inquiry about Thomas Amos and Catherine Devore. I find they were married in Jefferson Co., Kentucky 30 August 1788. The name of neither parent is given. The bondsman was James Richason and the officiating minister was John Whittaker. I find no others with the surname of Devore in this first marriage book of Jefferson County.

I looked through early wills of Jefferson County in the hope I would find some Devores and Amos's. Neither name is given. Of course, in our library there is not a full coverage of all early <sup>Jefferson</sup> county records many of which will be found in the court house. It is possible that research in those records would provide some facts or clues about the Devores. The 1790 Kentucky Tax List places one Daniel Devour in this county and he may be the father of Catherine. A Price Devore was a tax payer in Nelson County at that date.

If you would be interested in further research on this family, I suggest that you write Mrs. Clyde W. Hamm, 3507 Pine Cone Circle, Louisville, Kentucky 40222. She is an excellent researcher whose fine work

I do not hesitate to applaud and recommend. I am so sorry not to be able to find more information for you. In the DAR Patriot Index I found several Devores.

Were you able to travel up and down Bath Avenue here?

The late Ida Millis, wife of former governor Simson Willis, once wrote that she thought Bath Avenue was the most beautiful avenue in the state. This was before the Condit and Putnam homes were razed to make room for the Ashland Tower and the parking garage across the street from it.

Will you please do me a favor? Will you please check your computer for the name of Warren H. Devere?

Warren H. Devore, born 2-9-1840, in Carter County, Ky., was my great-grandfather. He was married to Sarah Jane Ball in Carter County, Ky. 7-30-1861 and was divorced from her in 1872. He was acquitted of killing his brother-in-law here in Ashland, and naturally his divorce resulted from the murder.

I don't know what happened to him after 1872. His parents were living in Lewis County, Ky. in the Census of 1880. In that Census, there was no mention of Warren, but in the A. B. and Catherine Devore family, there were two young girls listed with a woman old enough to be their mother.
