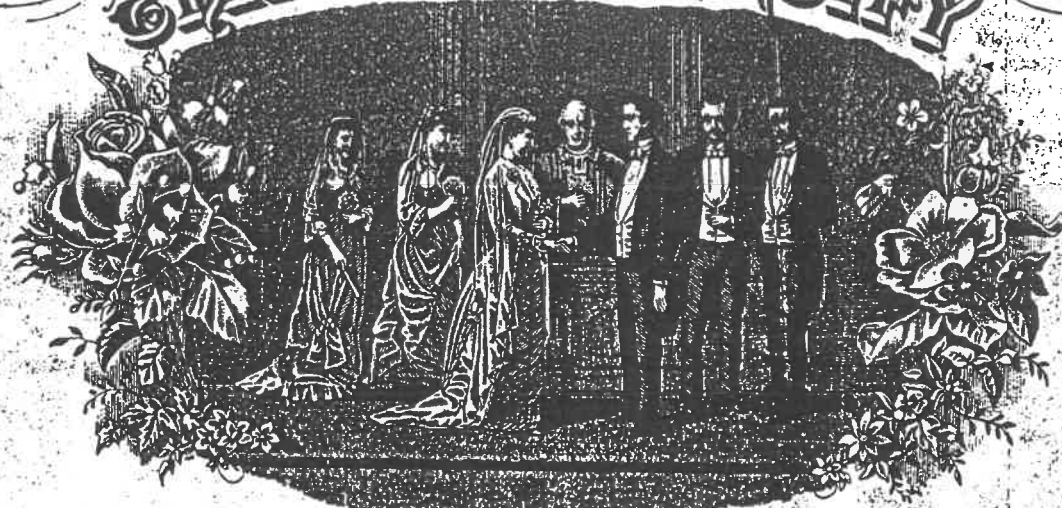
The Bible was in the possession of Futrell's daughter, Mrs. Claude A. (Viola Futrell) Bailey of Hopkinsville, KY in 1989. The title page was missing.

J.M. Futrell was a native of the Laura Furnace community in Trigg Co., KY. He taught at Laura Furnace School and served as Clerk of the Pleasant Hill Baptist Church. He moved to the county seat at Cadiz shortly after 1900 and from there to Hopkinsville, KY where he and his wife are buried at Riverside Cemetery.

behold the angel of the Lord appeared unto
him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son
of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary
thy wife; for that which is conceived in her
is of the Holy Ghost.

Nathan Futrell (1773-1829) was the drummer boy from Northampton County, NC who is buried at Futrell Cemetery in the Laura Furnace community of Trigg County, KY. In recent years, his gravesite has been fenced and there is a nearby Kentucky Historical Highway marker honoring him. A note with the family record section of this Bible record indicates the Bible was printed and sold by John Holbrook, Brattleborough, Vermont in 1816. It was in the possession of Mrs. Ethel (Futrell) Tucker of McLeansboro, IL for many years. Footnotes are added by Roger Futrell.
