Blessed Lord Jesus Christ! This is the  
earnest and never ceasing prayer of their

She has been vaccinated with the cow pox.


Arthur and Ellen had the Measles in the month of

the Parish of Chelsea on the 15th of Nov'r.


Arthur and Georgiana have had the hooping cough.

Began to read these Holy works seriously 23<sup>rd</sup> of April 1809


August 24<sup>th</sup> Oh great God! I grant, that- What I read in Thy

towards thee, that my heart may be truly dedicated in  
that I do, for I am taught th' god! and fully aware  
of thy well-pleased servants divine precepts, that mere external  
show to outward form, without the heart, would only be  
the means of throwing us miserable sinners further from thy  
divine presence, from thee th' god! who knowest the fraili-  
ties and infirmities of human nature, help this heart from  
all unprofitable desires, govern, and sanctify thou my thoughts  
so that the world not any human affection may ever have  
power to distract my mind from its duty towards thee.  
But grant that my heart may perfectly love thee, and  
do stately magnify thy holy Name, receive and remember  
this humble petition of thy servants th' god! when I may  
have got the dominion over me, I humbly beseech thee  
for Christ's sake, our blessed Lord and hope, Amen. —
