Blessed Lord Jesus Christ! This is the
earnest and never ceasing prayer of their

August 1817.

this humble petition of Thy servants for Christ's sake our
Blessed Lord and Savior! Amen. — Statute Mr. Bath —
August 25th 1809.

1809 10th Oh Heavenly Father! particularly save thy servant from
the great sin of Hypocrisy, that I may never wish to appear
to the world better than I really am; grant Oh God! that I
may never deceive myself in the motives of my devotion
towards Thee, that my heart may be truly actuated in
that I do, for I am taught Oh God! and fully aware
that our blessed servants divine precepts, that mere atten-
tion to outward form, without the heart, would only be
the means of throwing us miserable sinners further from Thy
gracious presence, than thou Oh God! who knowest the frail-
ties and infirmities of human nature, keep this heart from
all unprofitable, - dishonest, - govern, and sanctify thou my thoughts
so that the world nor any human affection may ever have
power to divert my mind from its duty towards Thee,
but grant that my heart may perfectly love Thee, and
do Thy will, magnify Thy Holy Name, receive and remember
this humble petition of Thy servants Oh God! when thou may
have got the dominion over me, I humbly beseech Thee
for Christ's sake, our Blessed Lord and Savior, Amen. —
