

Folder 54: CSA Printed Material and Union General Orders No. 6, 1862-1865

General Orders No. 6: Headquarters, Department of the Ohio, 1 September 1862, Major Charles L. Kilburn, Deals with the amount and what kind of supplies to be held in Union supply centers.

Broadside: Headquarters, Department No. 2, Glasgow, Ky., 14 September 1862, General Braxton Bragg. Calls on Kentuckians to support his Army in Kentucky and to enlist in the C.S.A. States that civilians will not be harmed and goods taken for supplies will be paid for by the Army. (2 Copies)

Broadside: Head Quarters, Confederate States Army in Kentucky, Bardstown, Ky., 29 September 1862, General Braxton Bragg. Calls for volunteers from Kentucky to help form 20 companies of Cavalry and any extra volunteers to form infantry units. (2 Copies)

Booklet: "Great Battle of Chickamauga: A Concise History of Events from the Evacuation of Chattanooga to the defeat of the Enemy", by S. C. Reid, F. Titcomb: Mobile, 1863. 16 pages.

Booklet: "Lt. Gen. Buckner Correspondence with Judge Moise", 33 pages. September to October 1864. Copies of correspondence Buckner sent to Moise about the court marshal and execution of A.W. McKee.

Printed letter: Headquarters Dist. West. Louisiana, Alexandria, October 21st, 1864. Letter to Judge Moise, uncut version of last letter in the prior booklet.

Broadside: Farewell Address, Headqr's Buckner's Corps, Shreveport, La., June 8, 1865. Open letter to his troops about the surrender of his troops.
