Dear Sir.

As my friend W. Paston expects to pass through your neighbourhood I have thought that I could not forego the opportunity of writing you a few lines.

My Mother-in-law and Sister Nancy, are now here and have been since some times in December last they, and my own family are well - & beg to be remembered to you and yours in the most affectionate terms.

We have lately received letters from Oran, which bring us the disagreeable intelligence, that Benjamin Porters wife is not expected to live long - her Complaint is dropsy - old Aunt Molly Pater has also been quite unwell - Other

Friends there are in usual health.

9/27/21

I have never heard
a word from Mr. Buckner on the
subject of the debt against Blakeman
altho I have written to him several times
for information concerning it. I shall
write to him to day by the gentleman
who carries this and as it will probably
reach him safely - shall expect a speedy
answer -

9/28/21

I hope you will do
whatever you can, in urging Mr. Buckner
to bring our suit to a conclusion - so that
we may get our money in specie or
in notes on the United States Bank - or one
of the Chartered Banks of Virginia - &
when it is ready - please inform me, or if
an opportunity offers - send it -
