Martial Law in Kentucky.

HEADQUARTERS DEPARTMENT OF THE OHIO,
CINCINNATI, OHIO, July 31, 1863. {

General Order, No. 120.]

Whereas, the State of Kentucky is invaded by a rebel force, with the avowed intention of over-awing the Judges of Elections, of intimidating the loyal voters, keeping them from the polls, and forcing the election of disloyal candidates, at the election on the 3d of August; and whereas, the military power of the Government is the only force that can defeat this attempt, the State of Kentucky is hereby

DECLARED UNDER MARTIAL LAW,

and all Military Officers are commanded to aid the constituted authorities of the State in the support of the laws, and of the purity of suffrage, as defined in the late Proclamation of His Excellency, Governor ROBINSON.

As it is not the intention of the Commanding General to interfere with the proper expression of public opinion, all discretion in the conduct of the election will be, as usual, in the hands of the legally appointed Judges at the polls, who will be held strictly responsible that no disloyal person will be allowed to vote, and to this end the military power is ordered to give them its utmost support.

The civil authority, civil Courts, and business will not be suspended by this order. It is for the purpose only of protecting, if necessary, the rights of loyal citizens, and the freedom of election.
