Some time back month you issued an order for
Commissions to be made out for Lt Henry M.
Cauley as Capt Co F, 17th Georgia Regiment; also one for Chas
A. Klink as 1st Lt in same Company, with instructions
for the Commissions to be immediately forwarded
to Gen Lee Col Benning, 17th Georgia, obtained leave
for a suspension of these Commissions until he
could be heard from by you, in regard to the
question of election over promotion. Since that
period, "Lt Henry M. Cauley" has resigned, and under
an election ordered by Col Benning, a private in
the Company, who enlisted through the influence of
a private bounty of ten dollars paid by him, has
been elected 1st Lieut. It is proper to remark
in this connection, that some time previous to the
period, but subsequent to the Conscription Act
under an election ordered by Col Benning, for
1st Lieut. P. W. Gittinger of said Company, had
been elected Captain. I now respectfully
request my recognition as Captain of said
Company, Co F, 17th Georgia, under the law, or an
acceptance of my resignation of 2nd Lieut, that I may not
be humiliated by a forced continuance in said Company, under
the circumstances stated.
