Lexington Kentucky June 29. 1865

Pursuant to Special Order No 35 issued on the 14 June 1865 by Col S W Price Post Commandant, the Board of Survey therein appointed, met at Transylvania University in the City of Lexington at the time specified and proceeded to make the examination of and ascertain the damages incident to the occupation of the Buildings of said University by the U S Authorities for Hospital purposes. In making said Examination they took the evidence of experienced Carpenters as to the cost of restoring the Buildings to the same condition in which they were when received by the U S Authorities and all evidence by them taken, together with a copy of the Special Order, is hereto annexed.

The Board of Survey Report that the damages incident to the Occupation of said Buildings by the United States Authorities for Hospital purposes, amount to Twenty One hundred and Sixty Six Dollars and they further report that the repairs ~~and~~ which are necessary in order to restore the Buildings to the condition in which they were at the time they were received by the U S Authorities will cost the amount above estimated.
