

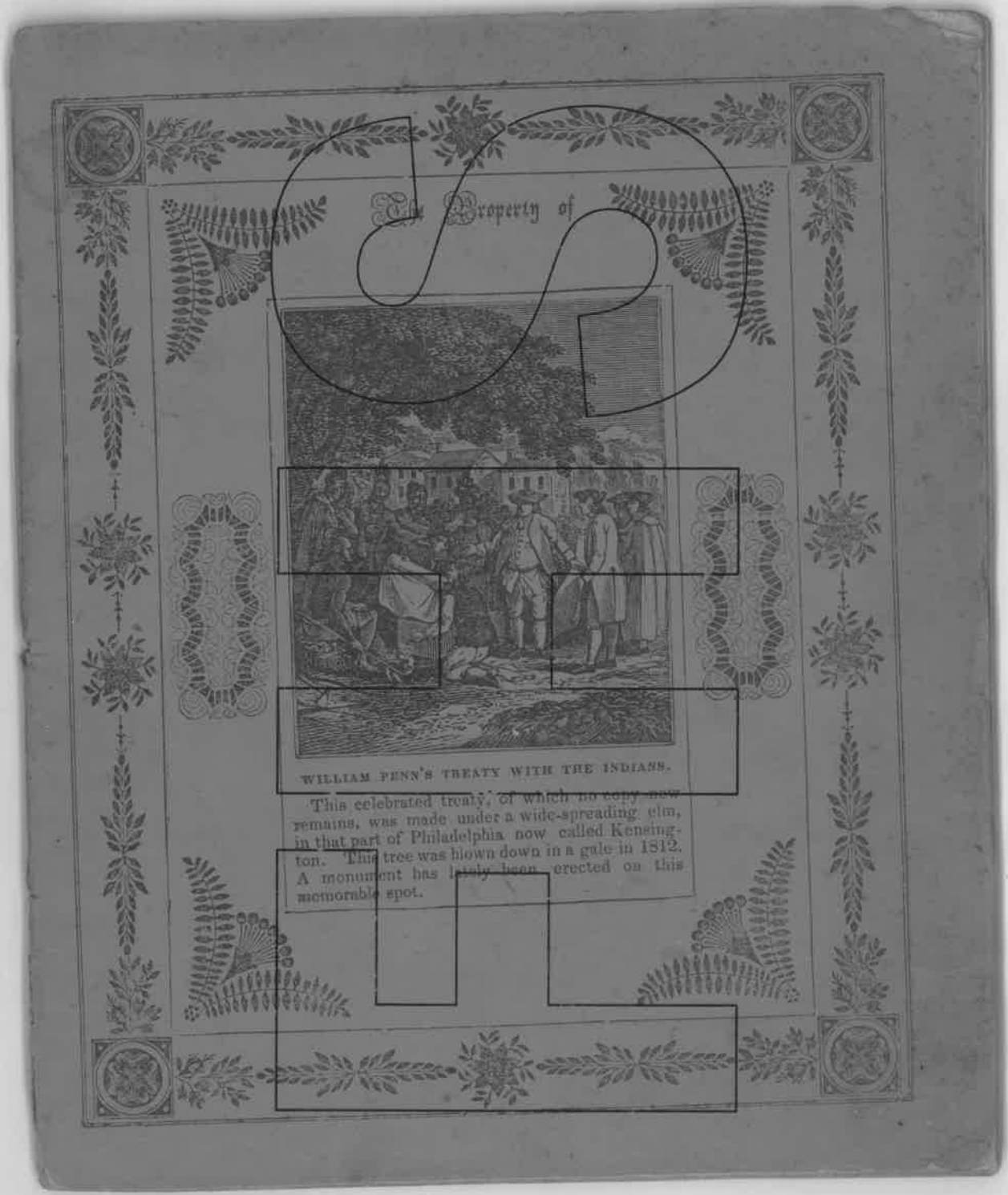

WILLIAM PENN'S TREATY WITH THE INDIANS.

This celebrated treaty, of which no copy now remains, was made under a wide-spreading elm, in that part of Philadelphia now called Kensington. This tree was blown down in a gale in 1812. A monument has lately been erected on this memorable spot.
