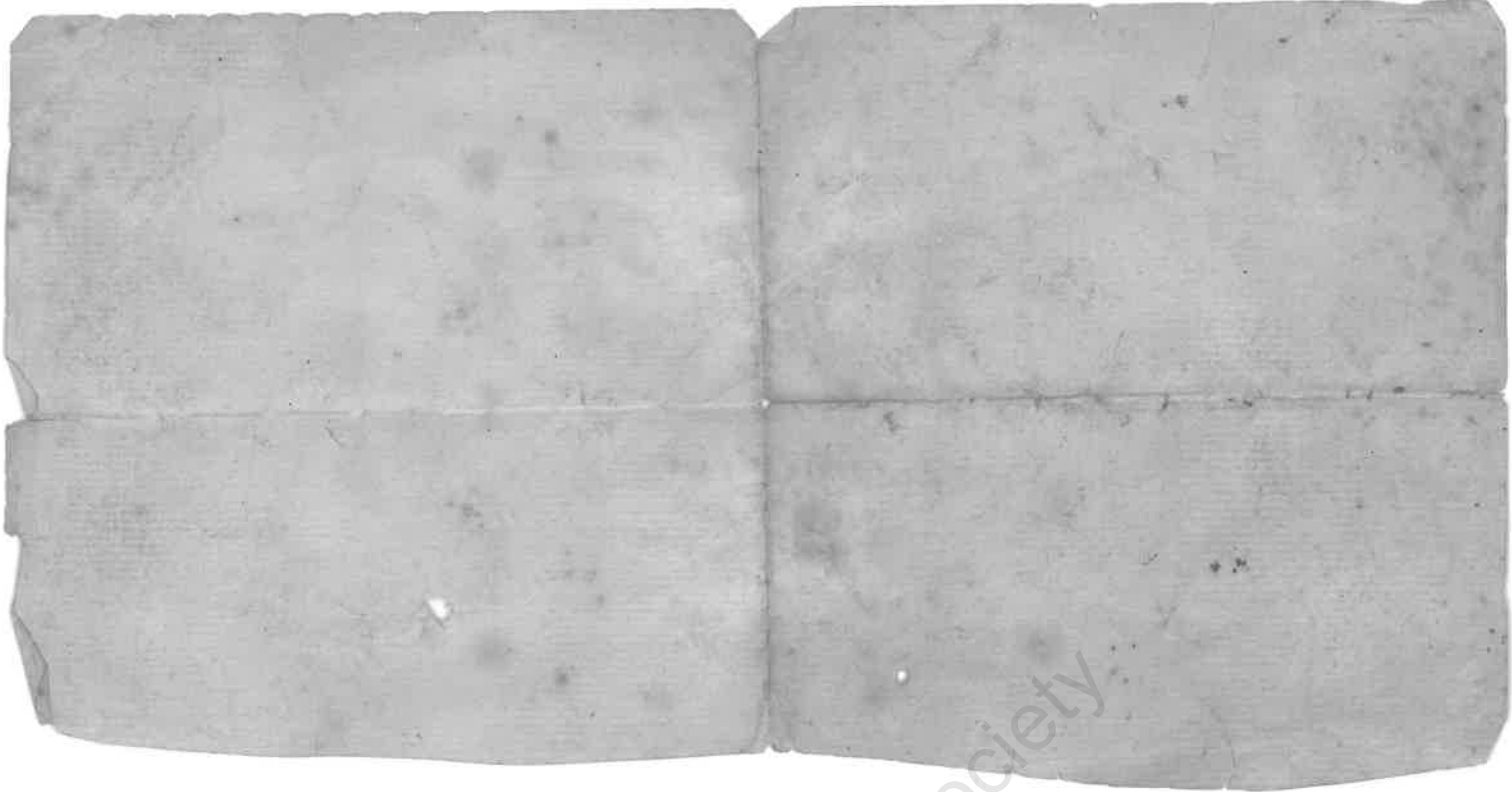
March 12 1803 Mr D. Williams payton you will please  
to pay Mr Moore sixteen gallons of whiskey and  
your Compliance will oblige yours D

and if your Bear Daniel Deller  
Gont <sup>works</sup> well Cart it a little higher and if it  
dont turn out well come down and I will  
give you some allcome strangelum and then you  
cant help making a good turn out

WHEREAS Jacob Alish of the 3<sup>rd</sup>  
division of the 121 survey, in the District of Ohio, possessor of one still numbered  
30510 and marked of the capacity of  
gallons, at this time erected in the county of Nelson in the said division, and owned by  
Daniel Weller hath duly notified his election to  
distil by license, agreeable to the act of Congress passed the 3d of March, 1797, and to pay the duty accruing to  
the United States, in consequence of the working or employing of the said still for and during the term of two weeks  
month in which he intends to work or employ the same, to commence on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of Sept.  
and to end on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of October both days included, and for which term he has de-  
fired a license. NOW KNOW YE, that I, James Morrison, Supervisor of the Revenue for the District of Ohio  
aforesaid, do hereby permit and license the said Jacob Alish  
to work and employ the said still in distilling from materials of the growth or produce of the  
United States, for the said term of two weeks, month as above defined, on the terms by him elected.
