Know all men by these presents that  
we John Sutton & Paul Christian Phil.  
Bradley William Sutton Geo. Sweetnam  
& David Sutton have this day sold  
unto John Sutton Esq. a Negro  
Woman & Girl. The Woman by the name  
of Milly. aged forty six. the Girl by the  
name of Lincy. <sup>aged twenty years</sup> for & in consideration of  
the sum of six hundred Dollars the  
Receipt whereof is hereof acknowledged  
& we bind ourselves our heirs &c. to  
Warrant & defend the Title of said  
Negroes. free from the Claim or Claims  
of all & every person or persons whatever  
as witness our hands & Seals. this  
2<sup>nd</sup> of Augt 1817
