2 cups buttermilk

1 cup lard

½ tsp. allspice

2 tps. soda
4 tbsps. cocoa
4 cups plain flour

Mix together the buttermilk, brown and white sugar, lard, and the jam.

Put all the spices in the flour and sift together.

To the first mixture, add a little of the flour mixture alternately with the raisins, stirring after each addition. When all is mixed well, pour into greased pans and bake in moderate oven for approximately 35 minutes.

Makes two eight-inch layers.

He might as well be talking to himself if he expects any response from her. Helen Smith believes in sticking with time-tested recipes and the idea of trying something new doesn't appeal to her at all.

"Scout's always trying to get me to fix some new recipe," she says with a laugh. "But whenever he asks, I try to ignore him."

About the last recipe Helen ever tried was cooking a ham in a lard can. It took some coaxing to get her to attempt it, but she hasn't cooked a ham any other way for the past 16 years.

"It'll fall apart when you get through cooking it that way," she said. "It's so tender."

Clean and trim the ham, and weigh it. Soak it in plain water overnight.

Pour the water off and add fresh water before you cook it. Placing a pan in the bottom of the lard can will keep it from sticking.

Cook the ham two minutes for every pound on medium heat on top of the stove. Don't start timing till water boils. Keep a lid closed tightly on the ham.

After cooking, remove from heat and cover can with quilt to retain heat. Leave ham covered for 24 hours.

Helen never did much cooking until after she married. She'd helped her mother in the kitchen when she was growing up, but husband Scout was the real Guineau pig during those first

2 cups buttermilk
1 cup white sugar

1 cup raisins
1 cup lard

½ tsp. nutmeg
2 tsps. soda
4 tbsps. cocoa
4 cups plain flour

Mix together the buttermilk, brown and white sugar, lard, and the jam.

Put all the spices in the flour and sift together.

To the first mixture, add a little of the flour mixture alternately with the raisins, stirring after each addition. When all is mixed well, pour into greased pans and bake in moderate oven for approximately 35 minutes.

Makes two eight-inch layers.

Brown Sugar Icing

1½ c. brown sugar
1 stick butter
½ c. milk

Boil ingredients together two minutes. Cool. Add 1½ cups powder sugar or enough to thicken it.
