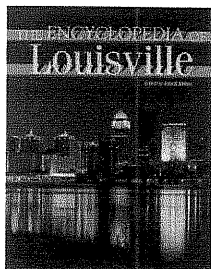


Metro Louisville, Jefferson County, KyGenWeb Project



This is an *extract from the Encyclopedia of Louisville published by the University Press of Kentucky in 2001. They have graciously allowed me to reprint the chapter in the book about the early history of Louisville, Kentucky cemeteries.*

Cemeteries

Throughout history, man has attempted to memorialize the dead in ways that the culture of family and the community sees fit. In the culture in which we live the prevailing habit is burial, with fitting ceremony, in a cemetery and with an identifying gravestone or marker. Throughout Louisville and Jefferson County a great variety of final resting places exist. While some are elaborately designed and maintained, others are simply and suffer from neglect. While some display handsome and ornate monuments and markers, others are simply, deteriorated, or have no markers at all.

In the first half of the nineteenth century, family cemeteries were widely used for interments, and rural families reserved portions of their property for the burial of the dead. There are hundreds of these graveyards scattered throughout Jefferson County. Many are well marked and kept by the descendants of the families, while others, because of development and the ravages of time, are lost. By the middle of the century, with increasing population and urbanization, public burial grounds became a more fitting and popular place for burial.

The first public cemetery was located on Jefferson Street between Eleventh and Twelfth and was used as early as 1786. This earliest burial ground is referred to as the Upper Jefferson Street Cemetery. By 1820 this first cemetery was found to be filling up so fast that a need for additional burial space was soon to come. The site was made into a city park in 1880 and named Baxter Square for the mayor at the time.

The second burial ground, Western, was established in 1830 between Fifteenth and Eighteenth Streets on Jefferson and referred to as the Lower Jefferson, or

pioneer, cemetery. The first Louisville city directory in 1832 includes a map by E. D. Hobbs that shows the "New Burying Ground." This second public burying ground officially closed in 1893, and many of those buried there were removed to other cemeteries. Today much of this cemetery lies in ruins, and only a few records remain. Many of the earliest citizens were laid to rest in this pioneer cemetery.

Some few years after the opening of Western, a need for a new burying ground in the east was realized. The Johnston family farm, called Cave Hill, was purchased. The cemetery was dedicated on July 25, 1848. Cave Hill, located at 701 Baxter Avenue contains the largest number of burials to date.

The Portland Cemetery was located at Thirty-sixth and Pflanz. A deed to the city of Portland was entered in 1847 by John Rowan for four acres of land to be used as a family graveyard. However, an early grave marked 1828 suggests that the graveyard may have existed prior to this 1847 date. The city of Louisville acquired possession of the cemetery in 1852 when Portland was annexed by Louisville. It contains the graves of many French families who were prominent in the early development of this area, as well as many other nationalities that played important roles.

The Schardein Cemetery, located on the east side of Seventh Street was opened as a family burial place and in 1878 became a public cemetery. It is presently owned by a private corporation.

Many communities such as Middletown and Jeffersontown maintained burial grounds. After the turn of the century more cemeteries were opened to fill the needs of the expanding county and city. The South Jefferson Cemetery opened in 1902 on Dixie Highway near Valley Station. Evergreen, located in south-central Jefferson County, opened in 1912, followed by Resthaven in 1926 on Bardstown Road. The Louisville Memorial Gardens opened in 1936 and serves the Shively area.

African Americans also have reserved areas for the burials of their communities. The Eastern Cemetery, located at 641 Baxter Avenue and Western Cemetery both had sections reserved for blacks in the early years. By 1886 the Louisville Cemetery opened on Poplar Level road in what was then a rural setting and in 1903 the Greenwood Cemetery opened at Fortieth and Greenwood. Only African Americans are

buried in these two cemeteries. Serving the Newburg area is the Forest Home Cemetery at 3650 Petersburg Road, which opened in the 1940s. A much newer burial place is the Green Meadows at 3506 Shanks Lane.

At the beginning of the nineteenth century, different religious congregations felt the need to separate burial grounds. These became the preferred places of burial, as proper care became the responsibility of the church members.

The first Catholic cemetery was located at Tenth and Main Streets on the site of the first St. Louis Church. When the new St. Louis Church was built on Fifth Street in 1830, the graves were removed to the Catholic portion of the Western Cemetery on Jefferson. The present-day St. Louis Cemetery did not open until 1867, and it is believed that many of those who were re-interred in the Western Cemetery were again removed to the newer St. Louis Cemetery in 1880. A portion of the Portland Cemetery as also reserved for Catholic burials.

St. Mary's or St. John's Cemetery at Twenty-sixth and Duncan began in 1849 and was the burying ground for the German Catholic community near Portland. The property for the cemetery was conveyed by deed November 30, 1849, by the Sisters of Charity of Nazareth to the Diocese of Louisville. The first burial took place in 1851. Another German Catholic burial ground, St. Stephen's, located on S. Preston and Rawling Streets, opened in 1851. Many German Catholics of the time were angered by the six-dollar fee charged for burial in the Portland Cemetery and were determined to keep the St. Stephen's ground separate from the church's holdings. A refusal to turn over the lot's deed led to heated exchanges and threats of banishment. Due to opposition from one of the local parishes and the Archdiocese, it is now cared for by a private organization.

St. Louis Cemetery, located at Barrett Avenue and Ellison Street was incorporated on May 28, 1872, but interments were made as early as 1867. This Catholic cemetery was laid out by local designer Benjamin Grove. St. Michael's Cemetery opened in 1851 on Texas Avenue near Goss, replaced St. Stephen's as a burial ground for the German Catholics. St. Andrew's Cemetery, located in southern Jefferson County near Pleasure Ridge Park, adjoined the Church of St. Andrew's, which was completed in 1851. St. Edward's Cemetery, located in Jeffersontown, opened in 1903, and served the Catholic population of that area. Calvary, 1600 Newburg Road, opened in 1921. This cemetery serves as the central repository for all Catholic burial records.

The earliest record of a Jewish burial site was Adath Israel, known as Hebrew Cemetery, first described in 1859. It was located on the southwest corner of Preston and Woodbine. The cemetery was moved to its present location on Preston Street, south of Eastern Parkway when Interstate 65 was constructed. At one time there was a Hebrew cemetery on the south side of Wathen Lane, west of Seventh Street Road, but about 1934 those buried there were removed to the cemetery on Preston.

Each of the Jewish congregations - The Temple (a merger of Adath Israel and Brith Shalom), Adath Jeshurun, Keneseth Israel, Anshei Sfarad, and Temple Shalom - has its own burial site. All but Temple Shalom own land on Preston Street; Temple Shalom uses a consecrated site in Cave Hill Cemetery. Across Preston Street from the others is Agudath Achim Cemetery, which retains its name though the congregation merged with Adath Jeshurun.

Many early Protestant churches also had suitable burial places for their congregations. The early Baptists had graveyards at the Floyd's Fork Baptist Church near Fisherville, Chenoweth Run near Jeffersontown. The Methodist, or as it is known today, the Eastern Cemetery, is located at 641 Baxter. It borders Payne Street and is next to Cave Hill on the southeast side. The land was purchased by the Fourth Street Methodist Episcopal Church South and the Brook Street Methodist Episcopal Church South as a burial place for their members. It was incorporated on March 4, 1854, but burials began as early as 1844. Also the Cane Run Methodist off Thurman Road, Mt. Holly in Fairdale, Fairmount off Bardstown Road, Hobbs Chapel in Anchorage all had cemeteries. The Presbyterians had burial grounds at the Cane Run Presbyterian Church near Fisherville, the German Reformed Presbyterian on the northeast corner of Shelby and Main in Jeffersontown, Bethlehem Presbyterian on the Old Taylorsville Road and at the early Pennsylvania Run Presbyterian Cemetery in southeast Jefferson County. A 1795 tombstone for William Cummins of Pennsylvania indicates that this is one of the oldest cemeteries in the county. The Lutheran Cemetery, located in Jeffersontown on Watterson Trail, opened in 1833, and the Mt. Zion Lutheran on Pope Lick Road in 1859. A Christian Church cemetery is on Poplar Level Road at the site of the Newburg Christian Church.

Some of the early cemeteries had reserved portions for the indigent, but by 1873 a burial site was chosen on Manslick Road. It was known as the pauper's graveyard, or the Manslick Cemetery. In the last few years a newer site was chosen in southwestern Jefferson County and named Southwest Memorial

Gardens.

Two important military cemeteries are also in Louisville. A portion of Cave Hill was set aside for the burial of Union soldiers. It is known as the Cave Hill National Cemetery and is maintained by federal contract with Cave Hill. An additional site in Cave Hill was purchased for the burial of Confederate soldiers. Another military cemetery is the Zachary Taylor National Cemetery, located on Brownsboro Road in eastern Jefferson County. This was once the private burying ground for the Taylor family and is the final resting place for the twelfth President, Zachary Taylor. The cemetery was officially made a national cemetery in May 1928.

While interment of the body remained the favorite practice, paying for burials became increasingly difficult during the Great Depression. This fact, coupled with potential land shortages within the city, inspired interest in an alternative means of disposing of the dead. In 1933 retired building inspector J. L. Obier embarked on a plan to build Louisville's first crematorium. Obier discussed his plans with several funeral home directors to discover if a crematorium would be suitable for the area and then took several trips to other crematoriums in Ohio and Indiana with the cemetery board. Louisville's Crematorium was a composite of the best features of these facilities.

In 1935 a site for the crematorium was chosen at 641 Baxter Avenue in the Eastern Cemetery. The building had two large furnaces into which the bodies would be lowered at temperatures approaching two thousand degrees Fahrenheit.

The first official cremation in the state of Kentucky took place there on December 13, 1935, and the Louisville Crematorium officially opened for business as a nonprofit organization on December 24.
