MANNING and ALLIED FAMILIES

<sup>Henry</sup>  
JOHN MANNING <sup>Jr</sup>, the leader of the Mannings into Meade county, was born in Maryland in 1775. He married Ann Gough, daughter of James Gough, and with his wife and young son Henry emigrated to Scott county. Shortly after, probably around 1810, the family removed to St. Theresa's parish, <sup>A</sup> where he died in 1835. His wife, Ann, passed away in 1836 at the age of 58 years.

The Will of John Manning, probated in January 1836, reads as follows: (Meade Co. Will Bk. "B", p.4.

" I recommend my soul to God and my body decently buried according to the rites of the Holy Catholic Church and religion, the religion to which I belong, and in which faith I wish to die."

Reference is then given to his sons: 1) John Henry (the Henry referred to above), 2) Edward F., and a <sup>grandchild</sup> niece, Ann Sevilla Manning, daughter of his deceased son 3) James. Also mentioned are his daughters: 4) Susan Greenwell, 5) Clara Roberts, and 6) Eliza Burch.

- 1) JOHN HENRY MANNING, born in Maryland in 1807, died in 1845, which was twice married. His first marriage, took place about 1827, was to Susan Gough, who was probably a daughter of Cornelius and Winifred Gough. She died in 1842, age 33 years. Their children were: A) Emily Teresa, B) Isabel, C) Susan Mary Winifred, D) John Henry, E) Thomas Jefferson, F) James William, G) Samuel Joseph, and H) Eliza Eleanor Manning.

His home was about 1 mi east of Moolyville Ky, near the Meade-Breckinridge Co line. on what is now known as the Allie Burch place. His land included what are now known as the Raymond Greenwell, Foot Brown, Allie Burch, Willie Kessels, Dr Sam O'Bryan, Paul Pike places and others. He donated land and logs for the original St. Theresa's church, formerly known as Flint Island Church.

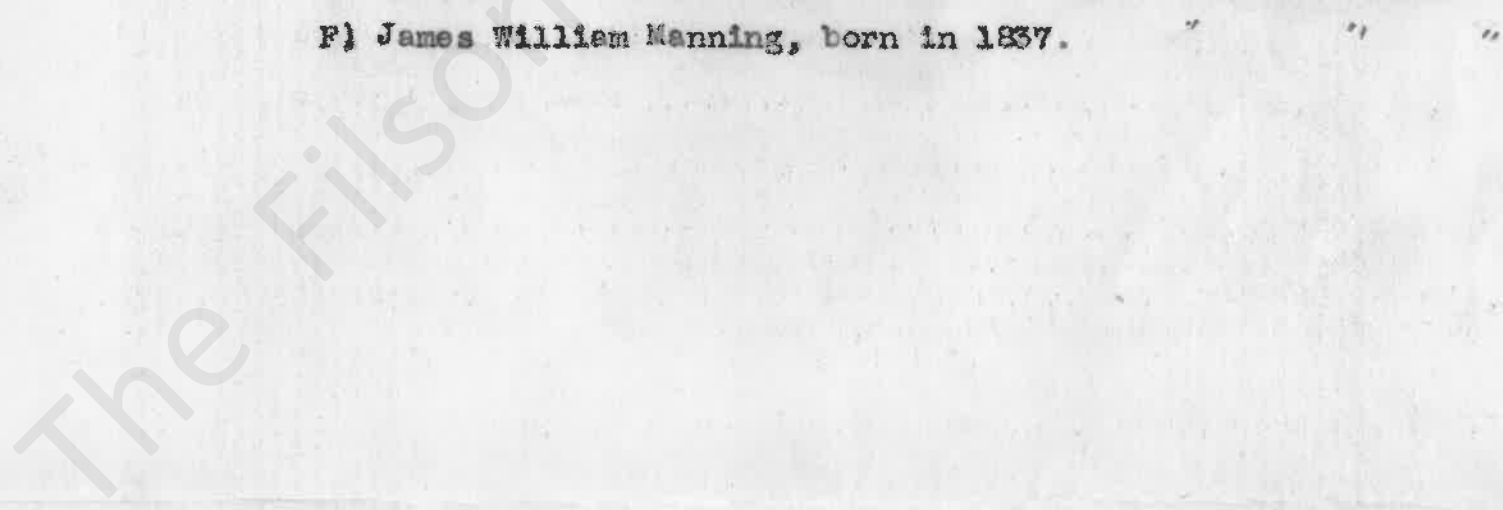

You seem to know so much about her family, I was wondering if you could help me with mine. I am a descendant of Thomas Acquiags Austin, son of James. I am especially interested in the records in Washington/Marion County and St. Rose Church.

I have a copy of the Centenary of Catholicity in Kentucky, Memoirs of the Lower Ohio Valley and the History of Union County, but not Onischab's book to which you referred in Mrs. Halter's letter.

I am also looking for information on John Manning who came to Kentucky from Maryland about 1790 and settled in Scott County, according to the Centenary of Catholicity in Kentucky. He married Ann Gough. I understand Gough is Gaelic for Smith. I don't know anything else about either Ann or John. There is family tradition that a Manning married an Indian squaw, but that is all we know. We don't know when, where or what tribe.

I am also looking for Drury's. Bernard and his wife Catherine Wimsatt came to Washington County, Kentucky from St. Mary's County, Maryland. They settled near Cox's Creek or maybe Fairfax. There is some indication that they were members of Holy Cross Church. The last time I was in Kentucky I looked for Holy Cross Church, but didn't find it.

I know I have asked a lot of questions, but my time in Kentucky is so limited that I don't have time to check records, etc. My mother, who is 89, is still living and when I go to Kentucky I spend all my time with her. We are so very fortunate to still have her. The dear Lord has been very good to us and to her, as she is in pretty good health. But I am sure you can understand why genealogy has to take a minor place in my visits to Kentucky.

Thank you for anything you can share with me. Our daughter was born in U'ville at St. Joseph's Infirmary in 1952. We were members of Holy Spirit Parish. I was wondering from your address, if you are stationed at the church across from St. Joe's. We have some very dear friends who attend that church, Margie and Johnny Furlong. Maybe you know them.
