John Wathen I [Sunt.]
 He was born in Bristol England, about 1625, and came to Saint Marys City in 1645. He was a man of means for in 1649 he was allowed 100 acres for transport of goods into the Province. In 1655 he took up 400 acres of land in Virginia; when the Albemarle County was formed, his land in Maryland fell in that county. There he died about 1699. His will is recorded at La Plata, Charles, Co. Md.

WATHEN GENEALOGY
(Wathen Line)

- I. John Wathen was born in England about 1625; died in England about 1698. He settled in St Mary's County, Maryland prior to 1647. Married Mary Mullett about 1650. She was born about 1630 and died after 1698. No record of any children except John Wathen II.
- II. John Wathen, son of John I, was born in Charles County, Maryland about 1662; died 1705. He married Susanna (Ann) Hudson, about 1678. She was born after 1665; died sometime after 1705. They had eight children of whom, Hudson Wathen was the fourth son. John Wathen was a carpenter by trade, as shown by early Maryland records, he was mentioned also as a collector of debt in the Archives of Maryland.
- III. Hudson Wathen, fourth son of John Wathen II, was born in Charles County, Maryland, about 1694; died 1760. He married Sarah Mudd about 1715. She was born about 1696 and died after 1760. They had ten children, three of whom were

- IV. Henry Hudson Wathen, son of Hudson Wathen, was born about 1741; died June 14, 1774. He married Susanna --(Name unknown) who died after 1774. His will dated Apr 22, 1774. Had five children whom were:

 - (3) John Baptiste
 - (4) Mary Ann
 - (5) Ann. (A Sister)
Elizabeth Mc Cermack.
- V. Henry Hudson Wathen II, born in St. Mary's County, Maryland, May 11, 1776; died June 22, 1851. Married (1st) a Miss Snowden, in Maryland, who bore him several children. (no record) (2nd) Mary Spalding, Apr 14, 1798. She was born Feb 1, 1773; died 1852. She was daughter of Benedict and Aletha Abell Spalding. Henry Hudson volunteered for service in the Revolutionary war as a boy of 17. He came to Kentucky in 1791, and became ~~XXXXXXXX~~ a man of considerable estate in Washington County. He left a will which was on record in the Court house at Lebanon, County seat of Marion County, but was destroyed when Court house burned in 1856. Henry Hudson & Mary Spalding had, as far as known; eight children?? Two of whom were:

Henry H Wathen was confirmed Sept. 16th 1849 at St. Lawrence church, St. Lawrence, Ky- According to the St. Lawrence census of 1889, he was still living- Rebecca his wife was born in Daviess County 1820- She passed away March 6th 1900- Buried in St. Lawrence cemetery-

FRANCIS X WATHEN

Francis X Wathen was born Dec. 4th 1847- St. Lawrence, Ky- He was baptized Jan- 24th. 1848.

He made his first Communion Nov. 18th 1860. He was confirmed June 16th. 1861 On the same day George Thomas Montgomery, who became a priest, and later a Bishop was a class mate- First Communion and Confirmation with Francis Wathen Bishop Martin J. Spalding administered confirmation.

On Nov. 16th 1871 Francis X Wathen married Julia Ann Pickrell in St. Lawrence church, St. Lawrence Ky. On the same day his sister Rosella, married Warren Lindsey- A double wedding.
