Biographical Note

William Clark (1795-1879), the son of Jonathan Clark and brother of George Rogers Clark was born in Louisa County, Va. on Nov. 13, 1795. In 1800, he came to Ky. with his father. He graduated from Jefferson Medical College in Philadelphia and moved to Huntsville, Ala. where he practiced medicine for just over one year. He moved to Fayette County, Ky. where he lived as a farmer. About 1835, he moved to Jefferson County. Clark was an early Ky. Mason who founded the Clark Lodge of Masons about 1818. He married Francis Tompkins of Louisville. Clark died in Louisville, February 3, 1879.

Scope and Content Note

Collection includes business and personal correspondence; an account book, 1812-1861; bills for the sale of slaves, 1829-1848; and land papers.
