1892	Graduated from the University of Notre Dame.
1913	His work <i>History of Muhlenburg County</i> was published.
1917- 1945	Served as secretary of the Filson Club.
1921	The Story of a Poet: Madison Cawein.
1924	The Outlaws of Cave-In-Rock.
1928	Began editing the Filson Club History Quarterly.
1956	Died in Greenville, Ky. and was buried in Huntinburg, Ind.

Scope and Content Note

Material consists of letters to Rothert congratulating him upon the publication of his *History of Muhlenburg County, Kentucky* and *The Outlaws of Cave-In-Rock*; copies of letters from Rothert to individuals and institutions requesting information about Mike Fink and the flatboat men, Samuel Mason, the Harpe brothers and other outlaws, and the history of Cave-In-Rock, Ill.; miscellaneous notes, clippings, and pictures; and copies of books and documents.
